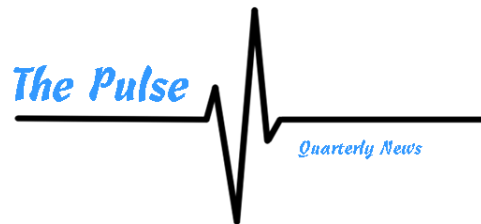
**International Association of Workforce
